DIRECTIONS

From the 91 Freeway, east or west, take the 71 Freeway towards Chino Hills, exit Euclid Ave. and take the first dirt road to the right.

From the North: Take the 57 Freeway South to the 71 Freeway, exit on Euclid Ave. and turn Left. Proceed North on Euclid just over the Freeway and take the first dirt driveway on the right.

RUNNING ORDER

Dogs will run in catalog order. It is the handler's responsibility to be ready to go to the first blind when called. Handler's with entries in more than one stake must report a conflicting running order to the Marshal before the start of the tests. Camouflage, or dark hunting attire, is required for all handlers and workers in the hunt test. Observers in the gallery should be in dark clothing and keep their talking to a quiet level to avoid distracting the working dogs. **Bitches in season are not allowed on the grounds.** There will be no training on the test grounds beginning 24 hours before the tests begin and until ALL tests are completed. Exercise/airing areas will be designated.

1. A land single of a shot bird over a distance of approximately 50 yards in light cover.
2. Back-to-back singles in the water. One bird should be retrieved in swimming water if possible.
3. The dog is not required to be steady or to deliver to hand; however, the judge(s) may designate an area for delivery.
4. The dog should not be gun shy.

Camo or dark clothing is NOT required for the Working Certificate Test.

REQUIREMENTS

A Conformation Certificate (CC) will be awarded to any Labrador Retriever over one (1) year of age that passes a conformation examination sanctioned by the LRC, Inc. and officiated at by an approved American Kennel Club conformation judge or provisional judge for the breed. Labrador Retriever specialty Sweepstakes judges, and Sporting Group judges for American Kennel Club events are also eligible to officiate.

To receive a Conformation Certificate, a dog is required to attain a score of 18 or better. To pass in each category a dog must demonstrate, in the mind of the judge, a 65% likelihood of conforming to the characteristic as described by the Standard.

Dogs must be 1 year of age or older on the day of evaluation. Spayed and neutered dogs can be evaluated.
